



## MGIS School Uniform Policy 2025-2026

All students are required to wear articles of the **approved uniform collection**, available at Zacks. The **School logo** should be visible at all times.



KG 1 - KG 3

KG students must wear the blue polo top or dress, with navy pants/shorts and white socks.

It is wise to leave an extra identified shirt in school for your child.

Elementary and Middle School students must wear the white polo (top) with short or long sleeves, with a navy bottom part (skirt or pants).



P.E. Uniform

For Elementary and Middle school students only, the Physical Education (PE) uniform is required for each PE class, and is allowed in class on those designated days **ONLY**.

Elementary Students may only wear shorts in class on designated days. Middle School students must wear gym pants during PE class.

Sports shoes are mandatory during PE classes (no spikes/studs football shoes).

### SHOES:

- Shoe colour should be sober and respect the colour code of the uniform (white, grey, black, blue, navy). **Closed shoes** must be worn at all times in class (no Crocs, sandals, or slippers).



### WARM CLOTHES (KG1 to Grade 9):

- Students can wear the hoodie from the Uniform Collection with the school logo in class if they are cold.
- **Personal hoodies and sweatshirts are not accepted in class.**
- Long-sleeve undershirts are accepted under the uniform (white, grey, black, or navy).

### OVERALL APPEARANCE :

- A discrete and clean appearance is required (No stained or damaged clothing).
- Students must come to school neat and well-groomed.
- No excessive jewelry, makeup, nail extensions, flashy nail polishing colours, hair and belt accessories, dyed hair, etc.
- Caps are not allowed in class, but are accepted outside. Personal caps are not permitted during school activities. Only the MGIS navy cap is accepted, which will be provided by the school.
- All students will pay close attention to body smells and may bring a deodorant stick (no spray bottle accepted), if needed.
- Students are not allowed to change or remove their uniform before the end of the day.

### NO-UNIFORM DAYS:

- On certain days only, students may be allowed to wear personal clothing of their choosing, according to the theme or celebration announced.

### OTHER:

- We expect parents to identify all items belonging to their child (such as school bag, cap, uniform, flasks, lunch box, etc.), which will help us sort out the lost and found uniform items.
- In case an issue arises with uniforms, students should speak immediately to the student supervisor (floor observer) to find a solution.
- Parents will be contacted if the school uniform policy is not respected or presents an issue.
