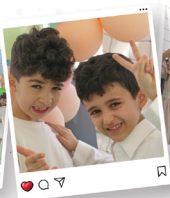
SAUDI FOUNDING DAY

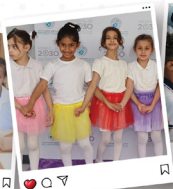
100 DAYS OF SCHOOL

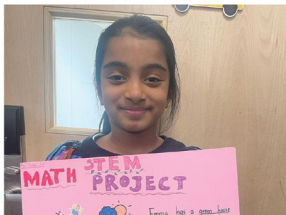

STEAM DISCOVERY CLUB

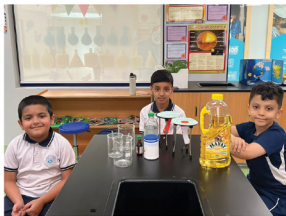
Students loved exploring the "why" behind the world around them. With hands-on projects and big ideas, this club turned curiosity into innovation.



SCIENCE CLUB



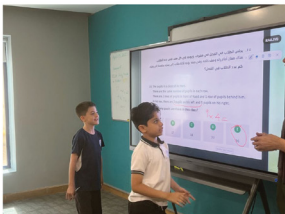

MENTAL MATH CLUB



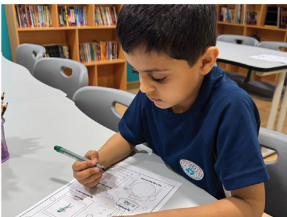
